Dear Sir/Madam.

I am to inform that the Post Graduate Admission Committee (PGAC) of the Faculty of Medical Sciences at its meeting held on 17.09.2014 considered the eligibility of PG students to submit protocol /thesis/to appear in the university examination, Session – 2014-2017 and decided as follows:-

- (i) the schedule of admission fixed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India order dated 18.06.2014 in the matter of Dr. Fraz Naseem & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors (I.A. no 15-2014 in WP (c) no. 433 of 2013).
- (ii) the session started on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014 and admission closed on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2014.
- (iii) the duration of PG Degree course is 3 years and Diploma course is 2 years. This includes teaching, research, clinical, patient care, submission of protocol/thesis, participation in journal club, tutorial, publication etc.
- (iv) the Session of PG courses used to be started from 2<sup>nd</sup> May of the year and the final examination used to be held at the end of the Session i.e. April/May of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year /3<sup>rd</sup> year (Diploma/Degree) courses.
- (v) Since the session has delayed by two months, these students may be eligible to appear in the University examination to be held in September /October 2017 instead of April/May 2017.
- (vi) To avoid hardship to the students, the PGAC after a length of discussions recommended as follows:
  - a. The student who joined the course on 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2014 are in shortage of training/research/attendance for 60 days. The shortage may be compensated in the following Manner:
    - i. Condone 15 days.
    - ii. Adjustment of leave for 10 days out of permissible leave of 30 days in 1st year.
    - iii. Adjustment of leave for 10 days out of permissible leave of 36 days in 2<sup>nd</sup> year.
    - iv. Adjustment of leave for 10 days out of permissible leave of 36 days in 3<sup>rd</sup> year.
  - b. The student who joined the course on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2014 are in shortage of training/research/attendance for 70 days. The shortage may be compensated in the following Manner:-

Condone 15 days.

- ii. Adjustment of leave for 10 days out of permissible leave of 30 days in 1st year.
- iii. Adjustment of leave for 15 days out of permissible leave of 36 days in 2nd
- iv. Adjustment of leave for 15 days out of permissible leave of 36 days in 3rd year.
- c. The Annual Examination scheduled for April/May 2017 for the Session 2014-2015 should be started from 15th April, 2017 and should be over by 07th May 2017 before start of summer vacations to avoid problem of non -availability of examiners.
- d. The dates for submission of thesis protocol / thesis will remain same.

It is requested that the students concerned be informed accordingly.
