Sub.:- Regarding Operationalization of National Scholarship Portal Version 2.0 (NSP 2.0).

Sir. Madam,

As you are aware that the Government of India has taken a decision as a key initiative under Digital India programme to process scholarships of Central Ministries/ Department electronically with payment released to the account of students directly. For the purpose, the revamped National Scholarship Portal (NSP 2.0) have been launched w.c.f. 01/07/2016 by GOL. Accordingly, to streamline the scholarship disbursal process during the current academic session all scholarship schemes are to be implemented on DBT through the revamped portal using Aadhaar as unique identifier for students. In this regard, the letters in respect of Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students (of MHRD) have already been circulated; this scheme is directly implemented by Colleges and Universities.

Now, the Secretary, Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC, GNCTD vide his D.O.letter dated 31/08/2016 (copy enclosed) has desired immediate actions regarding online scholarship schemes sponsored by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India. In this regard, as you are already aware that the Directorate of Higher Education implements one such scheme, namely, Post Matric Scholarship for SC & OBC students. Further, the DBT Mission vide its letter dated 15/07/2016, has suggested below mentioned actions to ensure successful on boarding schemes and seamless disbursal of scholarship through the portal:

- i) Student will register at NSP portal to get the Login Credentials and fill-up the entry form by entering complete details to get the registration id.
- ii) A single and simple form, common for all scholarships has been designed for registration of beneficiary on the portal capturing the basic details along with the details of Aadhaar and Bank account of the students.
- iii) Head of Institutions will ensure seeding of Aadhaar and Bank Accounts by the students of their respective Institutions before 12/09/2016. In case of non-availability of Aadhaar by a large section of students, efforts may be made by the Institutions to organize Aadhaar enrollment camp. However, students may also be encouraged to get enrolled for Aadhaar at the Permanent Enrollment Centers (details of these centers are available on http://resident.uidai.net.in).
- (iv) Records filled by students will automatically appear under the login of respective College/ Institutes/ University. The Head/ Principal/ Registrar of concerned Institutes shall enter the portal with their login credentials in order to examine the beneficiary details and shall validate, authorize and approve the student records within a period of 30 days using their Digital Signature and submit the validated data at the NSP portal. For the purpose, Head of all Institutions shall ensure procurement of Digital Signature, if not available with them yet, by 15/09/2016.

v) All Institutes shall nominate the Nodal Officer for National Scholarship Portal v solely responsible to enter the accurate DIAS/HIAS Code of its Institution and programmes offered by them, to facilitate the beneficiary student to select his/her Institutes/Universities in a single click at NSP portal.

vi) Once the students data is approved by the respective Colleges/ Institutes/ Universities the data will automatically move to State Authority, who can view the entire data through their Login Credentials for further examination. In case of any discrepancy in data, the State Authority should either call the Nodal Officer of Institute to correct the data or may reject the particulars of entire data of concerned Institute.

vii) Supporting documents for scholarships amount less than Rs.50,000/- to be kept at Institution level and for scholarships amount more than Rs.50,000/- should be uploaded on the portal.

viii) For ready reference, it is informed that to avail Post Matric Scholarship (SC) the parental income from all sources should not be more than Rs.2.50 Lakhs per annum and other details regarding eligibility may be seen at the website of Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, GOI and under the 'Guidelines' of National Scholarship Portal.

In view of the aforementioned details, you are, therefore, requested to take all requisite actions timely to ensure that no eligible student deprived off the benefit of Post Matric Scholarship during 2016-17. In case, there are affiliated Colleges/ Institutes with the University then it should be ensured by the University concerned that all such Colleges/ Institutes follow the guidelines regarding NSP 2.0 to enable their students to avail scholarship schemes.

With reference to this office letter No. F.11(32)/Sch/DSCST/P. File/2016-17/3827-36 dated 05/08/2016 regarding online scholarship schemes sponsored by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India and Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India, guidelines issued by DBT Mission, Govt. of India regarding of National Scholarship Portal 2.0 is also enclosed. As per the guidelines, there now appears to be a significant change under the methodology of processing of scholarship applications compared to the earlier years. Application forms will no longer be scrutinized and processed by the Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC but will have to be done by the concerned departments (i.e. Department of Education, Higher Education, Technical Education, Municipal Corporations, Kendriya Vidhyalya Sangathan, Directorate of Cantonment Education Board) to which the student pertains. It may kindly be noted that the NSP-2.0 also requires scrutiny of forms first at the level of the institution in which the student is studying and for which the educational institution is required to obtain log in and digital certificates in order to access scholarship portal. .

02. Further the first level scrutiny as well as the retention of documents will be the responsibility of the educational institution itself. The Nodal Department / concerned departments may inspect/ audit the forms at any time in the institutions of its jurisdiction. Further, the case where the claimed amount is less than 50,000/-uploading of documents on the portal is not required. However, where the amount is higher than 50,000, documents are to be uploaded as per requirement. Moreover, the concerned department will have to nominate nodal officers, preferably district wise to validate and authenticate the data. Further a nodal officer department wise of sufficient seniority will have to be nominated at the state level for interacting with coordinating department i.e. Department for the Welfare of SC/ST/OBC. The operational Guidelines on National Scholarship Portal for students is also enclosed herewith.

You will kindly appreciate that in order to make the new process a success, considerable care and effort will have to be committed in enhancing capabilities at various levels including providing assistance to students to access the portal, various levels including providing assistance to students to access the portal, requirements etc. The deadline for portal, upgradation or enhancing of hardware requirements etc. The deadline for submission of application forms under the schemes being 30th September, 2016 and 31st October, 2016, the required action will need to be taken on priority basis. At state level, steering committee is being constituted under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary for monitoring the progress of the schemes, a meeting which is likely to be held shortly.

As you are aware, Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) programme has gained momentum and its implementation is being monitored at the highest level. In this regard, DBT Mission has already issued orders (vide Ministry of Finance O.Ms (No. !-11011/58/2013-DBT) dated 13th and 19th February, 2015) for universalisation of DBT across Ministries and Schemes where cash benefits are provided to individuals. Now, the scope of DBT had also been expanded to include in-kind transfers as well as transfers made to various enablers of Govt. Schemes (vide DBT Mission's O.M. dated 31st-March, 2016-copy enclosed). The said O.M. also specifically lays down that Ministries / Departments are required to establish internal DBT Cells for facilitating transition of their Schemes on the DBT platform.

2. It may be mentioned that Hon'ble Prime Minister has reviewed the progress of 'DBT and Aadhaar on 9th May, 2016, wherein stiff lines for implementation of DBT were laid down. These include - DBT Cell in all Ministries & States by 30th June, 2016, all DBT disbursal to be Aadhaar linked by 31st December, 2016 and all Subsidies and Welfare Schemes to be brought under DBT by 31st March, 2017.

3. You will agree that for meeting the above timelines, each Ministry / Department will have to constitute internal DBT Cells for on-boarding various welfare schemes on DBT. These Cells may be headed by a Joint Secretary level or above officer and comprise of IT experts, coordinating with respective Program Divisions and IFD for the DBT transition of Schemes. This has to be followed by a live MIS portal under each Scheme for capturing real time information about various beneficiaries and underlying transactions at Central Ministry / Department level. Subsequently, all implementing agencies have to be on-boarded on the IT platform and fund flow has to be integrated on the PFMS platform.

4. A number of Ministries/Departments like Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries, Ministry of Environment & Forests & Climate Change, Department of Sports, Department of Science & Technology, Department of Agricultural Research and Education, Ministry of Home Affairs have already constituted such internal DBT Cells and are working towards the DBT transition exercise of their Schemes.

Scholarships commencing from the academic year 2015-16 onwards are being disbursed through the portal. The initiative has resulted in streamlining and fast tracking the release of scholarships. There however continues to be under-utilisation of the scholarships; only about 50% of the target was achieved in the preceding year. One reason for the low utilization has been lack of student awareness about the scheme and of the fact that applications need to be routed through the NeSP portal. From this financial year (2016-17) onwards, Aadhaar has been made mandatory for disbursement of all Government subsidies/scholarships which would be disbursed directly into the beneficiary's bank account which has been seeded end Edu, with an Aadhaar number. I would be grateful if you could kindly give directions to your State Education Board to give wide publicity to the scheme and its linkage with National e-Scholarship Portal (NeSP), as well as the fact that Aadhaar is now mandatory. The Board may be asked to upload this information on their website at the earliest. A copy of the letter relating to implementation of Aadhaar based DBT, from the Cabinet Secretariat is attached. Aadhaar is also an identifier for receiving and processing scholarship applications. Applications for scholarships need to be submitted through the National Pl. brief 2. Scholarship Portal (http://scholarships.gov.in/) where the Aadhaar number of the Shall be beneficiary would be required while applying. For the scholarship scheme administered by this Department, that is, the Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University students, the last date for applying online is 30th September, 2016. In view of this, it is necessary that all students, who are entitled for a scholarship, are enrolled for Aadhaar. Sey (Wider, For Direct Benefit Transfer, the bank accounts of the beneficiary need to be serial of August 2016. If there are large number of students in a higher education institution requiring Aadhaar number, then enrolment camps in the institution itself may be organised to obtain biometric data. If the number to be covered is small, then the scholarship holders may be taken to the nearest Permanent Enrolment Centre by the respective institutions. Once the Aadhaar number is received. seeded with the Aadhaar number. The Higher Education Departments in the States are scholarship. You are requested to advise District Collectors to map the institutions and enrolment centres in the district and prepare a roster for organising enrolment camps wherever required. In nutshell, the applications under the Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students need to be routed through NeSP Portal of GOI and proper awareness among students in this regard must be ensured by taking all suitable steps.
