Suggested framework for MD Final Examination in Community Medicine to be uniformly applied to all Medical Colleges under FMSc, Delhi University.

1. THEORY (Total marks=400)

- Four theory question papers of 3 hours duration and 100 marks each.
- Out of these one shall cover Basic Medical Sciences and one shall cover Recent Advances.
