Revised Time Schedule for 3<sup>rd</sup> / Mop-up Round of Counselling under 85% Delhi Quota for admission to BAMS/BUMS/BHMS for the academic session 2021-2022

(A) **Seat Allotment in 3<sup>rd</sup> / Mop-up Vacancy Round of Counselling:** There will be seat allotment in the 3<sup>rd</sup> / Mop-up Vacancy Round of Counselling strictly accordingly to merit/marks of NEET UG 2021.

(B) **Eligibility for 3<sup>rd</sup> / Mop-up Vacancy Round of Counselling and tentative vacancy position:** List of eligible candidates under Delhi Quota which has provided by AYUSH Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC), Ministry of Ayush, Govt. of India after 3<sup>rd</sup> / Mop – up Round of AACCC – UG Counselling and tentative vacancy positions for BAMS/BUMS/BHMS are available on faculty website [www.fmsc.ac.in](http://www.fmsc.ac.in). under Faculty of A & U and Homoeopathic Medicine. In this regard, candidates are also advised to check regularly website of AACCC, Ministry of Ayush.

**Eligibility Condition/Requirement for admission to BAMS/BUMS/BHMS course under 85% Delhi Quota:** Please see Bulletin of Information 2021 which is available on the website of Faculty of Ayurveda & Unani and Faculty of Homoeopathy, University of Delhi.

The candidates who have not qualified the NEET UG 2021 Examination conducted by NTA are not eligible.

(C) Fee to be paid online after allotment of seat: Only those candidates who are allotted seats in colleges affiliated to University of Delhi, after successful allotment of seats by the University of Delhi are required to register themselves for admission online at Faculty of Ayurveda & Unani and Homoeopathy, University of Delhi website [www.fmsc.ac.in](http://www.fmsc.ac.in). They are required to complete the Registration by uploading their documents, photograph, signature and the online payment of registration fee.

(D) Original Documents with two set of self-attested photocopies to carry. As per Bulletin of Information, Candidates appearing in 3<sup>rd</sup> / Mop-up of Counselling and offered admission in such round must carry their original certificates in person and they will have no right to surrender their seats once accepted and No extension of time for joining will be granted.

The candidates are required to bring following documents in Original as well as two sets of Photocopies (self-attested) during reporting 3<sup>rd</sup> / Mop-up Round of Counselling as per schedule given above:

- (i) Passport size photograph of the applicant
- (ii) Self –attested copy of NTA NEET-UG-2021 Admit Card
- (iii) Self –attested copy of NTA NEET-UG-2021 Score Card
- (iv) Self-attested copy of Aadhar Card
- (v) Scanned signature of the applicant

- (v) Scanned signature of the applicant
- (vi) Self-attested copy of Matriculation Certificate for verification of date of birth
- (vii) Self- attested copy of High School/Matriculation/Secondary examination Certificate for admission to BAMS course he/she should passed Hindi/Sanskrit as one of the subject at qualifying examination For BAMS course only).
- (viii) Self- attested copy of High School/Matriculation/Secondary examination Certificate for admission to BUMS course he/she should passed Urdu as one of the subject at qualifying examination (For BUMS Course only).

Or

The candidate who is not passed Urdu or Arabic or Persian language as one of the subjects in the 10<sup>th</sup> Standard or in 12<sup>th</sup> Standard, shall have to study Urdu language along with Arabic and Mantiq wa Falsafa (Logic and Philosophy) as a subject during the first Professional B.U.M.S session.

- (ix) Self- attested copy of High School/Matriculation/Secondary examination Certificate for admission to BHMS course, he/she should passed English as one of the subject at qualifying examination (For BHMS Course only).
- (x) Self-attested copy of 10+2 Mark sheet
- (xi) Self-attested copy of 10+2 Certificate
- (xii) Certificate from the Principal of the School on prescribed proforma available at faculty website: www.fmssc.ac.in stating that (i) the school is situated within National Capital Territory of Delhi, (ii) the school is recognized by the CBSE/Council for the Indian School Certificate/ Jamia Milia Islamia, (iii) the school is conducting regular classes, (iv) the applicant has attended regular classes in the school for class (standard) 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>. (only PDF & size 200 KB) (Important Certificate).
- (xiii) Self-attested copy of Character Certificate in proforma as prescribed by CBSE, issued by the Principal of the school last attended or any Gazetted Officer.
- (xiv) Self-attested copy of Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe certificate as described in Section –B, clause 1A, if applicable.
- (xv) Self-attested copy of OBC Certificate as described in Section–B clause B, if applicable.
- (xvi) Self-attested copy of Person with Disability (PwD) certificate as described in Section -B Clause C, if applicable.
- (xvii) Entitlement Certificate for C.W. category as described in Section–B Clause D, if applicable.
- (xviii) Self-attested copy of Non-creamy layer certificate of the current financial year (i.e. after 01/04/2021) and OBC caste certificate as per the Central list for OBC.
- (xix) Self-attested copy of EWS Certificate as described in Section–B clause E, if applicable.
- (xx) Self-attested copy of Overseas citizens of India (OCI) card, if applicable
- (xxi) Please note that the candidature is subject to the candidates fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirement prescribed in BOI for 85% Delhi Quota.

(E) **Last Date of Joining of candidates:** As per AACCC schedule, the last date of admission during the course is 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. Therefore, after successful allotment of seat, the candidate is advised to report to concerned college immediately. In no case, the extension of the joining time will be considered.

(F) All admissions will be provisional.

All the stake holders are requested to refer the Bulletin of Information in BAMS/BUMS/BHMS 2021 and regularly visit website of www.fmssc.ac.in for further updates.

All the candidates are requested to visit the Faculty website to check slot wise reporting for 3<sup>rd</sup> Mop-up Vacancy round of Counselling.
