BAMS/BUMS/BHMS - 2022-23 ADMISSION UNDER 85% DELHI QUOTA

- It is notified to all concerned that the admission to BAMS/BUMS in the Faculty of Ayurveda & Unani Medicines and BHMS Course in the Faculty of Homoeopathic Medicine, University of Delhi under 85% Delhi Quota for the session 2022-23, will be undertaken on the basis of marks /merit of NEET-UG-2022-23 conducted by NTA.
- Only, the eligible candidates, who have registered themselves online on website www.fmsc.ac.in upto 05.01.2023 till 5 p.m. will be considered to participate in the Counselling for admission to BAMS/BUMS/BHMS Courses under 85% Delhi Quota .
- 3. The schedule for the Online Counselling is as follows:

3.	Publication of result of 1st round of Counselling as per merit list for each course (BAMS/BUMS/BHMS) at Faculty Website.	(Thursday) 12th January, 2023
4.	Reporting at allotted Institute/College for admission by the candidates who have been offered seat in the lst Round of Counselling for each course (BAMS/BUMS/BHMS).	(Friday to Monday) 13th January, 2023 from 16th January, 2023 (Reporting time from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.)
5.	**Display of merit list of eligible candidates for 2nd Round of Counselling.	(Thursday) 19th January, 2023
6.	Reporting at allotted Institute/College for admission by the candidates offered seat in the 2nd Round of Counselling for each course (BAMS/BUMS/BHMS).	(Friday to Monday) 20th January, 2023 from 23th January, 2023 (Reporting time from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.)

- * Discrepancy, if any, must be brought to the notice of Assistance Registrar (A&U, H) by email only, at ar@fmsc.du.ac.in latest by (Wednesday) 11.01.2023 till 3 p.m.
- ** The 2nd round of counselling will be held only if any seats remain vacant after 1st round of counselling.

Important Instructions to the candidates for participating in the UG Counselling:

- 1. The merit lists of each course shall be published on the Faculty Website as follows
 - a) Common merit/rank list of all categories
 - b) Categories wise merit lists (SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD/CW)
- 2. The candidates are advised to download "Provisional Allotment Letter" from the faculty admission portal on the basis of the merit list at the following links:

- 3. The candidates who have been allotted seat's in the round -1 are instructed to join the respective Institute/college within the stipulated reporting period.
- 4. The candidates shall report to the College/Institute along with Provisional Allotment Letter and the following originals certificates for verification and the completion the admission process:
 - (i) Passport size photograph of the applicant
 - (ii) Self-attested copy of NEET-UG-2022 Admit Card
 - (iii) Self-attested copy of NEET-UG-2022 Score Card
 - (iv) Self-attested copy of Aadhar Card
 - (v) Self-attested copy of Matriculation Certificate for verification of date of birth
 - (vi) Self-attested copy of 10+2 Marksheet
 - (vii) Self-attested copy of 10+2 Certificate
 - (viii) · Certificate has attended regular classes in the school for class (standard) 11th & 12th.
 - (ix) Self-attested copy of Character Certificate in Performa as prescribed by CBSE, issued by the Principal of the school last attended or any Gazetted Officer
 - (x) Self-attested copy of Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe certificate as described in Section B, clause 1A, if applicable.
 - (xi) Self-attested copy of OBC Certificate as described in Section-B clause B, if applicable.
 - (xii) Self-attested copy of Person with Disability (PwD) certificate as described in Section –B

 Clause C, if applicable
 - (xiii) Entitlement Certificate for C.W. category as described in Section –B Clause D, if applicable.
 - (xiv) Self-attested copy of Non-creamy layer certificate of the current financial year (i.e. after 01/04/2022) and OBC caste certificate as per the Central list for OBC's.
 - (xv) Self-attested copy of Economically Weaker Section (EWS) certificate as described in Section

 —B Clause E, if applicable
 - (xvi) Self-attested copy of Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card, if applicable.

Note: <u>The candidates are required to bring Printout of Registration Form, Provisional Allotment letter alongwith Original Certificates alongwith (02 sets) of self-attested photocopies at the time of admission at the respective allotted College.</u>

- The candidates, who have been allotted seats in round-1 and not reported in the respective College /Institute, will not be eligible to participate in the 2nd round counselling in any case.
- 6. The candidates are advised to visit Faculty website www.fmsc.ac.in Faculty of Ayurveda & Unani Medicines and Faculty of Homoeopathy Medicines, regularly, for any updates.
