(For admission to MD/MS/Post Graduate Diploma Courses - 2018 Academic Session)

- NEET-PG is an eligibility-cum-ranking examination prescribed as the single entrance examination to various MD/MS and PG Diploma Courses as per Section 10(D) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. No other entrance examination, either at state or institution level, shall be valid for entry to MD/MS/PG Diploma Courses.
- National Board of Examinations has been notified by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to conduct NEET-PG 2018 on an All-India basis.
- NBE shall be conducting NEET-PG as a Computer Based Test (CBT) on 7th January 2018 in a single session at all the test centres.

Eligibility Criteria for NEET-PG 2018

Candidates in possession of MBBS degree/Provisional MBBS Pass Certificate from a
Medical College/Institute duly recognized as per the provisions of the Indian Medical
Council Act, possessing either a permanent or provisional registration certificate of
MBBS or equivalent qualification issued by the Medical Council of India / State Medical
Council and have completed one year of internship or are likely to complete the same
on or before 31st March 2018 may apply for NEET-PG through online application
system at www.nbe.edu.in

Applying for NEET-PG 2018

Candidates can register for **NEETPG** through online portal from **31**st **October**, **2017** to **27**th **November**, **2017**. Candidates can choose the exam city through online registration system on first come first serve basis.
