MCC is receiving lot of E-Mails as well as letters from Students/ College Authorities wherein the students who have got selected in AIIMS/ JIPMER/ PGI Chandigarh, now want to resign from their allotted seats in All India Quota/ Central/ Deemed Universities.

In this regard your attention is drawn to W.P. (c) 267/2017 DAR-US-SLAM EDUCATIONAL TRUST and Ors. Vs. MEDICAL COUNCIL OF INDIA and Ors. dated 09.05.2017 in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India stating that:-

"After the second round of counselling for All India Quota seats, the students who take admission in All India Quota seats should not be allowed/ permitted to vacate the seats. This would ensure that very few seats are reverted to the State Quota and also All India Quota seats are filed by students from the all India merit list only. The students who take admission and secure admission in Deemed Universities pursuant to the second round of counselling conducted by the DGHS shall not be eligible to participate in any other counselling."

The College/ University may take decision in this regard, at their level keeping in view the above Hon'ble Supreme Court's direction. Any Complaint/ Legal Complication arising out of allowing these resignations may be dealt with by the college at their level. MCC/ DGHS/ MoHFW will not be responsible for any Legal Complications.
