- → ADMISSIONS WILL BE MADE ON "NEET ALL INDIA RANK" PURELY ON MERIT
- →"NEET ALL INDIA RANK" shall be referred to as 'Rank' further in this schedule.
- → The Candidates who did not register are not eligible for Counselling.

Candidates are requested to check the University website very regularly for updates or any other important / supplementary schedule /information even after display of this Schedule of Mop Round.

- Notification read alongwith the University's Schedule 1. This is to be GGSIPU/Admissions/BDS/2017/22998 dated 4.8.2017; Schedule of 1st Round of Counselling, No. IPU-7/Counselling/Admission/01/BDS/2017/23033 dated 8.8.2017 and 2nd .IPU-7/Counselling/ Counselling. No. Schedule of Round of Admission/01/BDS/2017/23344 dated 17.8.2017.
- 2. It is stated that the vacancy arisen due receipt of withdrawal or any other reason, shall be filled up during this Mop Up Counselling.
- 3. It is reiterated here that, however, this is a Common Counselling, eligibility criteria and other terms and conditions of admission would continue to be applied in accordance with the provisions of the two Universities. So, the candidates are requested to refer to the Admission Brochure / Bulletin of Information of both the Universities.
- 4. <u>Number of Seats</u>. The number of seats, to be filled up during the Mop Up Counselling shall be displayed at the time of counselling. However, a tentative number of seats is mentioned here below in the succeeding paras. The candidates are advised to visit the University website regularly for updates.
- 5. Any candidate, who had taken admission during the 1st or 2nd Counselling and subsequently had withdrawn, is also eligible to attend the counseling as a fresh candidate. However, he/she will have to complete all the formalities including submission of Demand Draft etc.

- 6. Any candidate, who had taken admission in 1st or 2nd Counselling is eligible to change his college. For this purpose, he/she shall bring a Demand Draft of Rs.5000/- (five thousand) only in the name of 'Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University', payable at Delhi.
 In such cases, where the candidates would change their college, the seat vacated by them shall be offered to the next eligible candidate in merit. Further, any candidate who shall take admission, for the first time, during the Mop Up Counselling, shall bring a Demand Draft of amount, as mentioned in the succeeding paras.
 - 7. The Mop Up Round will commence from 'NEET ALL INDIA RANK" 01 onwards for all categories and the seats will be allotted strictly on the basis of merit. The candidates who were absent in the first counselling or second counselling, will also be permitted to attend the Mop Up counselling.
 - 8. For Eligibility, Documents required at the time of counselling, Authority Letter, Fees, Age Bar, Age Relaxation please refer to the above mentioned notifications / schedules and Admission Brochure 2017 of GGSIPU / Bulletin of Information of Faculty of Medical Sciences, University of Delhi.
 - 9. Admission will be made strictly on merit basis and the <u>counselling / admissions will</u> <u>stop when all the seats get filled up.</u> Notice regarding closure of counselling will be displayed on University's website.
 - 10. If the seats of sub-categories (i.e. Defence and PWD/PH) remain vacant, then they shall first be reverted to the parent category. Thereafter, the conversion of SC, ST, OBC to General Category shall be done. Any unfilled seat reserved for ST category will be offered to SC category and vice versa and only after completing this exercise, the conversion of the reserved category seats to General Category shall be effected. Any, SC/ST vacant seat in ACMS, the same shall be converted to the seats for 'Wards of Army Personnel' after exhausting the complete list of that particular category.

With regard to Conversion of seats in University of Delhi, Bulletin of Information of FMSC, DU may please be referred. It is reiterated here that, however, this is a Common Counselling, eligibility criteria and other terms and conditions of admission would continue to be applied in accordance with the provisions of the two Universities. So, the candidates are requested to refer to the Admission Brochure / Bulletin of Information of both the Universities.

- 11. All the candidates claiming seats in Defence Priority (I to VII) shall visit the University on the notified date and time.
- 12. All the candidates have been called to ensure that no seat remain vacant. <u>However, the counselling shall stop as and when the seats are filled up.</u> Inconvenience caused is regretted.
- 13. Any candidate, who had taken admission (during 1st or 2nd counselling) in any reserved category / sub-category shall not be allowed to change/vacate his/her seat, if the counselling for that category/sub-category (which is being vacated) is already over (during the Mop Up Round), for the reasons that, at that time, there shall be no claimant for such vacated seat because the counselling for that horizontal category would have already over. E.g. if a candidate had taken a seat in a horizontal sub category 'DOBCDEF' during 1st / 2nd Counselling; reports for change of seat in 'DOBC' / 'DGEN' category / any other category and vacate the 'DOBCDEF' seat, shall not be permitted because the counselling for horizontal category i.e. 'DOBCDEF' would already be over; and this being the final round of counselling.

- 14. Any category candidate, which have not been called and/or whose vacancy does not depict in the 'vacancy position' may attend the counselling as an unreserved category candidate and/or the vacancy may arise consequent to the conversion of categories during 2nd round of counselling. This is tentative vacancy position and may change. Final vacancy shall be displayed at the time of counselling.
 - 15. For acceptability of reserved category certificates and other terms and conditions etc; with regard to University of Delhi, all the candidates are requested to please refer to the Information Bulletin of Faculty of Medical Sciences, University of Delhi.
 - 16. Fee to be paid at the time of Counselling
 - (a) At the time of counselling / admission in the University, a candidate will mandatorily bring a demand draft of Rs.40,000/- (i.e. 39,000/- fee and Rs.1000/- Counselling Participation Fee) and a separate Demand Draft of Rs.1000/- (Non-Refundable Counselling Counselling Participation Fee) in the name of "Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University", payable at Delhi. If any candidate opts for a seat in GGSIPU, he/she shall pay the DD of Rs.40,000/-. If he/she opts a seat in DU, he/she shall pay the DD of Rs.1000/-only. Balance fee is to be paid at the allotted college directly.
 - (b) In the interest of the candidates it is advised to prepared DD of both the amounts, if they so desire, to get the seat in any of the college of both the Universities.

- vi) Copy of Admission verification form (duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 4(B) given in Part B, Admission Brochure 2017-18.
- vii) Preference Sheet (duly filled by candidate as per Appendix 7 given in Part B, Admission Brochure 2017-18.
- viii) Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate for verification of date of birth;
- ix) Marksheet of Class XII
- x) The candidates must bring proof of having passed 11th standard exam (under 10+2 scheme) from Delhi (i.e. Marksheet and/or format of passing 11th from the School located in Delhi; available as Annexure C (attached)
- xi) Character Certificate from the head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination was passed or from Gazetted Officer.
- xii) SC/ST/OBC Certificate, if applicable (Original and One Photocopy).
- xiii) Appendix 1, Part B, Admission Brochure 2017-18 alongwith the relevant entitled certificates, if admission is claimed in Defence Category.

20. **MEDICAL FITNESS**

The candidates shall undergo medical examination at their allotted college. ΑII candidates must be medically fit as per statutory body norms for admission.

21. UPGRADATION / CHANGE FEE

Any candidate, who opted a seats in 1st or 2nd Mop Round of Counselling, is eligible for upgradation / change of college during the process of Mop Up Round of Counselling. However, he shall pay a fee of Rs.5000/- (five thousand only), in addition to the 'Fee to be paid at the time of counselling', if such case occurs.
