

ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

MBBS/BDS ADMISSION UNDER 85% DELHI QUOTA
SESSION: 2018-2019

A. Registration for online Counselling:

1. It is notified that from this academic year i.e. 2018, the registration of counselling for 85% Delhi Quota will be undertaken by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (Government of India) through online mode. There will be no registration for MBBS/BDS counselling on University of Delhi/Faculty of Medical Sciences website.
2. The candidate seeking admission to MBBS/BDS courses - 2018 in colleges affiliated to University of Delhi under 85% Delhi Quota are requested to kindly refer to Ministry of Health & Family Welfare website www.mcc.nic.in for their registration and for subsequent online counselling for year - 2018 as per schedule to be specified by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (Government of India).
3. Indian Nationals/Overseas Citizen of India who have passed 12th class examination under 10+2 system conducted by the C.B.S.E/ Council of the Indian School Certificate Examination/ Jamia Milia Islamia, New Delhi with required subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English from the recognized schools conducting regular classes situated within the National Capital Territory of Delhi only, will be eligible for admission. The candidates who have studied 11th and 12th standard through regular classes from a recognized school within the National Capital Territory of Delhi only are eligible to apply. Further the candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology and English separately and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks (40% marks in case of SC/ST/OBC category candidates) taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology". The applicants may refer to Bulletin of Information 2018 will be available at faculty website www.fmsc.ac.in
4. The candidates must have qualified the NEET UG -2018 Examination conducted by CBSE.

B. Admissions (after successful allotment of UG (MBBS/BDS) seats by MCC for 85% Delhi Quota):

1. Only those candidates who are allotted seats in colleges affiliated to University of Delhi, after successful allotment of seats by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (Government of India) are required to Register themselves for admission online at Faculty of Medical Sciences, University of Delhi website www.fmsc.ac.in online link - Application for admission to MBBS/BDS for 85% Delhi Quota. They are required to complete the Registration by uploading their documents, photograph, signatures and the online Registrartion fee of Rs. 1,500/-(Gen and OBC) Rs. 1000/-(SC/ST/PWD)
2. Before initiating the registration for admission, the candidates are advised to refer to UG (MBBS/BDS) Bulletin of Information 2018 thoroughly.
3. Any candidate, who has not been allotted any seat in University of Delhi under 85% Delhi Quota or if otherwise ineligible to register for admission, somehow registered himself/herself on www.fmsc.ac.in, in such cases their registration will be invalid and no refund of fees will be done under any circumstances.
