1. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES:-

- 1.1 The candidates may obtain Bulletin of Information and Application Form from the Office of the Deputy Registrar (Medical), Faculty of Medical Sciences, 6th Floor, V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007 in the following manner:
- (i) By hand In person against bank draft for Rs. 1,500/- (Rs. One Thousand Five hundred only) for General Category and OBC Category candidates and Rs. 1,000/- (Rs. One Thousand Only) for SC/ST/PH category candidates as per details given in **clause 1.2.** between 9:30 A.M. to 12:30 P.M. and 2:00 PM to 03:00 PM on all working days **upto 07.01.2010.**
 - (ii) By post Against bank draft for Rs. 1,550/- (Rs. One Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty only) for General Category and OBC Category candidates and Rs. 1,050/- (Rs. One Thousand and Fifty Only) for SC/ST/PH category candidates by sending a self addressed envelop of 10" X 8" **up to 29.12.2009** as per details given in **clause 1.2.**

Note: Request received thereafter will not be entertained, even if the request is posted before 29.12.2009. The Delhi University will not be responsible for delay/loss in transit of the request for supply of Bulletin of Information by post, for any reason whatsoever.

The last date for supply of Bulletin of Information by post is 29.12.2009.

Money in cash will not be accepted in any case for supply of Bulletin of Information

- 1.2 All payments to the University should be made by a crossed Bank Draft/ Banker's Cheque drawn on any Nationalized Bank in favour of the Registrar, University of Delhi payable at Delhi. The candidate should mention his/ her name and address at the back of the Bank Draft/ Banker's Cheque. The candidates are advised to retain a photocopy of the Bank Draft/ Banker's Cheque.
- 1.3 The candidates, before filling in the form, should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for admission to the course. The candidates are required to go through the Bulletin of Information carefully and acquaint himself/ herself with all requirements.
- 1.4 This Bulletin contains only brief extract of the ordinances, rules, and regulations of the University. The candidates should, therefore, acquaint themselves with the relevant ordinances, rules, and regulations, of the University, the Medical Council of India and Dental Council of India regarding eligibility requirements payment of fee, attendance, examination, and other matters pertaining to their respective courses.

The candidates should seek the information with regard to the payment of salary, hostel and other facilities from the concerned College/ Hospital/ Institution.

- 1.5 The various terms and conditions mentioned in the Bulletin of Information are subject to the changes made in the ordinances, rules, and regulations by the University from time to time as per the decision of the Academic Council/ Executive Council and also binding regulations/ directions of the Medical Council of India. The University reserves the right to amend the ordinances, rules, and regulations, at its discretion as and when considered necessary.
- 1.6 The medium of teaching and examination for all the courses shall be English.
- 1.7 The candidature for the PGMET is **strictly provisional** and merely the appearance at the Entrance Test will not entitle the candidate for admission, which will be subject to the candidate's fulfilling all the requirements for admission. Those candidates who are not eligible would apply at their own risk and would not be entitled for admission if at a later stage it is detected that they are not eligible as per rules.
- 1.8 The candidate shall fill-in the application form in his/ her own handwriting in BLOCK LETTERS written neatly and legibly with blue/ black ink within the prescribed space.
- 1.9 Over writings, cuttings, erasings in the application forms may lead to rejection of forms and should be avoided. Any error arising on this account shall be the responsibility of the candidates.
- 1.10 The candidates shall comply with all the instructions while filling-in the application form.
- 1.11 The University of Delhi will not be responsible for any postal delay or irregularity resulting in non/late delivery of the Admission Ticket for any reason whatsoever. In case a candidate does not receive his/her admission ticket, if otherwise eligible, he/she may contact the office of Deputy Registrar (Medical), Faculty of Medical Sciences, 6th Floor, V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007 personally along with a copy of photograph between 04-02-2010 and 05-02-2010 for issue of duplicate admission ticket. Duplicate Admission Ticket will not be issued after the start of the Examination, for any reason whatsoever.
- 1.12 The candidate, who has passed a **Post-Graduate Degree** course, will not be given admission to **Diploma Course** in the same subject.
- 1.13 The candidate who is already pursuing any Course as on 10-04-2010 will not be eligible for admission.
- 1.14 The candidates, who were offered a Post-Graduate seat in counselling during the year 2007, 2008 and 2009 in case of Post-Graduate Degree and during the year 2008 and 2009 in case of Post Graduate Diploma and had accepted the offer but not joined the course before the stipulated date, shall not be eligible for admission during the year 2010.
- 1.15 Objection by any candidate should be filed with the Deputy Registrar (Medical) latest by 22-03-2010.

- 1.16 In case of any dispute, the decision of the Post-Graduate Admission Committee shall be final. However, an appeal may lie with the Vice-Chancellor, University of Delhi against such a decision.
- 1.17 Application Forms, which are incomplete in any respect, will be summarily rejected. Further, no alteration will be allowed to be made in the Application Form after it has been submitted to the Faculty Office. The candidate is required to fill the admission ticket attached with the application form and return the same along with the Application Form.
- 1.18 The in-service candidates should submit their applications through proper channel or attach a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their employer to the effect that they have no objection and the candidates will be relieved/ granted study leave for pursuing the course. The last date for submission of NOC is 31st March, 2010.**
- 1.19 After declaration of result of Post-Graduate Medical Entrance Test (PGMET), a candidate who is in service and who is likely to get admission, should initiate the process of obtaining Study Leave/ getting relieved so that he/ she is able to join the course concerned by the stipulated date.
- No candidate shall be allowed to join a course unless he/she has been relieved/ sanctioned study leave from his/ her employer.**
- 1.20 The candidates may apply for rechecking of their answer sheets **within seven days from the date of declaration of PGMET** result on payment of Rs. 300/- on the prescribed form available at office of the Faculty of Medical Sciences. If there is any change in the result after Re-checking, the candidate concerned will be informed accordingly before counselling.
- 1.21 The candidates shall not be informed individually regarding their position in the merit list or regarding appearance before the Post-Graduate Admission Committee for counselling. The candidates concerned should report to the Conference Center, Opposite Department of Botany, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007 at 9:00 A.M. on specified dates for MD/MS/Diploma counselling and at 02.30 PM for MDS course.**
- 1.22 No TA/DA will be admissible for appearing in the Entrance Test, Counselling and/or joining the course.
- 1.23 The selected candidates will be required to undergo medical examination by a duly constituted medical board at the assigned institution at their own cost on the specified date. A candidate if he/she is found medically unfit for the course, will not be allowed to join the course, his/her admission would be cancelled.

- 1.24 It is mandatory for a candidate admitted to any course to get himself/ herself registered with the Delhi Medical Council/ Medical Council of India/ Dental Council of India within one month of joining the course, failing which his/ her admission shall be cancelled.
- 1.25 The Post-Graduate Admission Committee reserves the right not to admit any candidate in a course(s).
- 1.26 For all the legal matters, the jurisdiction will be the National Capital Territory of Delhi only.**
- 1.27 Applications in the prescribed form (copy enclosed) duly filled in by the candidate in his/her own handwriting and complete in all respects should reach to the office of the Deputy Registrar (Medical), Faculty of Medical Sciences, 6th Floor, V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007 on or before 07.01.2010 upto 3:00 p.m. by hand or by Registered Post or by Speed Post only. The completed Application Form received after 07.01.2010 (03:00 P.M.) will not be entertained, even if the completed application form is posted before the last date i.e. 07.01.2010.
- 1.28 Any change in ‘address for communication’ should be promptly communicated to the Deputy Registrar (Medical) through Registered Post-AD or by Speed Post by the candidate. Every effort will be made to send communications on the new address. However, no responsibility can be undertaken for the same and the candidates are advised to make their own arrangements to collect the correspondence from the address (es) given in the application form.
- 1.29 The candidates should appear at the Examination Centre as allotted to them on the stipulated date and time mentioned in their Admission Ticket.
- 1.30 Candidates should preserve their Admit Card till the completion of admission process and produce the same during counselling and at the time of joining the course.

2. POST-GRADUATE DEGREE/DIPLOMA AND MDS COURSES:

2.1 Courses, Institutions, and number of seats:

The Faculty of Medical Sciences offers 24 Post-Graduate Degree, 13 Post-Graduate Diploma Courses and 4 MDS Courses as per details mentioned in Table I, II and III respectively given at page nos. 23-25

2.2 Reservation for Schedule Caste (SC)/ Schedule Tribe (ST) and Other Backward Classes (OBC) category candidates:

A. Reservation for Schedule Caste (SC) and Schedule Tribe (ST) category candidates:

Fifteen percent (15%) seats are reserved for candidates belonging to SC and seven & half percent (7½%) seats for ST candidates and it will be implemented as per 200 point

Roster. The manner in which the Roster would be implemented is as per methodology adopted by the PG admission Committee and approved by the University dated 25.04.2009

In MDS course reservation for SC/ST/OBC candidates, would be as per 13 point Roster following the same methodology.

The above said reservation would be applied and worked out after excluding All India seats and not against the total number of seats.

Provided that, if any seat(s) reserved for the candidates belonging to SC and ST categories remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible candidate(s) under that category, shall be filled in the following manner:

- (a) Such unfilled seat(s) will be offered to the eligible candidates of the other category i.e. seat(s) of SC category to ST category candidates or vice-versa as the case may be.
- (b) If the seat(s) remain unfilled even after applying the above provision, the same shall be offered to the candidates on open merit.

A SC/ ST candidate while applying for admission to any of the courses, should enclose a copy of the certificate alongwith the Application Form to the effect that he/she belongs to Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe Category from any one of the competent authorities as listed below without which, concession of Scheduled Caste/ Tribe shall not be given:

- (i) District Magistrate/ Additional District Magistrate/ Deputy Commissioner/ Collector/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/ Deputy Collector/ 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/ City Magistrate (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner).
- (ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
- (iii) Revenue officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- (iv) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/ or his/ her family normally reside.
- (v) Administrator/ Secretary to Administrator/ Development Officer (Laccadive and Minicoy Islands).

B. Reservation for OBC category candidates:

OBC category of candidate while applying for admission to any of the courses, should enclose a copy of the certificate alongwith the Application Form to the effect that he/she belongs to OBC Category duly certified by one of the competent authorities as listed below. However, the OBC status is to be determined on the basis of the Central List of OBCs notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes available at their website (<http://ncbc.nic.in/backwardclasses/index.html>).

The authorities competent to issue Caste Certificates are indicated below:

- (i) District Magistrate/Additional Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate).
- (ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate.
- (iii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- (iv) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and /or his family resides.

The candidate should not belong to Creamy Layer. The proof of non-creamy layer certificate issued by one of the Competent Authorities as mentioned above should be submitted alongwith the Application Form.

In order to become eligible for admission an OBC category of candidates must obtain 540 marks out of 1200 i.e. 45% marks in the PGMET-2010.

Provided that, if any seat(s) reserved for the candidates belonging to OBC categories remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible candidate(s), the same would be filled up by open merit.

Extent of Reservation in favour of OBC candidates would be as per the provisions of the Central Educational Institution (Reservation in Admission) Act 2006 and the permitted increase in the seats and it will be workout following the 200 point Roster alongwith reservation in favour of SC/ST.

2.3 Reservation for Physically Handicapped candidates:

Three percent (3%) seats shall be reserved horizontally for the candidates belonging to the Physically Handicapped category,

The distribution of seats amongst different subjects shall be decided by draw of lots.

The Physically Handicapped candidates having disability of lower limbs from 50% to 70% only are eligible and may apply as per the guidelines of the Medical Council of India.

Note: In the event of all the seats not being filled up from among the Physically Handicapped candidates with the above stipulated physical disability then the seats will be offered to the candidates with the physically disability between 40% to 50% (vide Medical Council of India letter No. MCI-34(41)/2007-Med./23553 dated 18.12.2007) who may also apply.

The application form should be accompanied by certificate certifying valid permanent physical disability issued by a duly notified Medical Board of a District/Government Hospital set up for examining the physically challenged candidates under the provision of the persons with Disability (equal opportunities, protection of rights and full participation) Act 1995. The certificate should indicate the extent of permanent physical disability (i.e. percentage) and it should bear the photograph of the candidate concerned and it should be countersigned by one of the Doctors constituting the Board issuing the certificate.

In case Physically Handicapped candidates belong to SC or ST or OBC category should also enclose appropriate certificate as mentioned in **clause 2.2**.

Note: The student should certify whether he/she belongs to OBC/SC/ST/PH Category. However, the OBC status is to be determined on the basis of the Central List of OBCs notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes available at their website (<http://ncbc.nic.in/backwardclasses/index.html>).

2.4 Duration of Courses:

2.4.1 The duration of course for Post-Graduate degree including MDS Courses shall be three completed years including the period of examination, provided that in case of candidates having a recognized two years Post-Graduate diploma course in the same subject the duration of course shall be two years. Candidates having diploma in a subject, if they seek admission in Post-Graduate degree course in any other subject, will have to undergo 3-years-course as prescribed.

2.4.2 The duration of Diploma course shall be of two years.

2.5 Requirement for admission to Post-Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses {except MD (Community Health Administration), and D.H.E.}:

- 2.5.1 The candidate must have passed final M.B.B.S. examination for MD/MS Course and BDS examination for MDS Course of University of Delhi and must have completed satisfactorily one year compulsory rotating internship as on 31.03.2010 and must submit their internship completion certificate before or at the time of appearing for the counselling.
- 2.5.2 The candidate must have full registration with the Delhi Medical Council/ State Medical Council/ Medical Council of India/ Dental Council of India.
- 2.5.3 A candidate in order to become eligible for admission must obtain 600 marks out of 1200 i.e. 50% marks in the PGMET. Provided that candidates belonging to SC and ST categories shall be required to obtain 480 marks out of 1200 i.e. 40% marks in the PGMET and in case of OBC category of candidates shall be required to obtain 540 marks out of 1200 i.e. 45% marks in PGMET.
- 2.5.4 The candidates should be medically fit to pursue the allocated course on medical examination.

2.6 Requirements for Admission to M.D. (Community Health Administration) Course:

- 2.6.1 A candidate must have completed satisfactorily one year of compulsory rotating internship after passing the final M.B.B.S. examination.
- 2.6.2 The candidate must have full registration with the Delhi Medical Council/ State Medical Council/ Medical Council of India.
- 2.6.3 The admission of the candidates be made strictly according to the merit based on the PGMET – 2010.
- 2.6.4 The candidate must have put in 5 years of service on or before 31-03-2010.

2.7 Requirements for Admission to Diploma in Health Education (D.H.E.) Course:

The candidates seeking admission to the above course shall satisfy the following conditions on or before 31-03-2010:

- (a) Bachelor's Degree in Medicine and Surgery recognized by Medical Council of India with at least one year's experience of working in General Medicine/ Primary Health Centre/ Department of Preventive and Social Medicine or Community Health or in a Medical College. Preference will be given to those candidates who are in service.

OR

- (b) Master's Degree in selected Social Science (i.e. Psychology/ Sociology/ Anthropology/ Social Work/ Economics /Political Science/ Education or Nursing, from recognized University with at least one year's experience in community health welfare programmes or teaching in Social Biological Science/ Physical

Education / Home Science. Preference will be given to those candidates who are in service.

OR

- (c) Bachelor's Degree in Social Sciences as stated in (b) above or Home Science/ Nursing/ Education or Public Health from a recognized University, with at least three years experience in community health and who are in service.

2.8 Procedure for submission of application form for admission:

2.8.1 Candidates, who wish to apply for more than one of (i) M.D. (Community Health Administration), (ii) Diploma in Health Education (D.H.E.), (iii) Other Post-Graduate (Degree/ Diploma) and MDS courses, should apply on separate application forms for each of the above mentioned courses.

2.8.2 The application complete in all respects must also be accompanied by attested copies of the under-mentioned certificates as per requirement of the course applied:

1. High School/ Higher Secondary Certificate for verification of date of birth.
2. Certificate in support of educational qualification: M.B.B.S. Degree/BDS Degree/ Master's Degree/ Bachelor's Degree – as per requirement of the course.
3. Detailed marks certificate of qualifying examinations: I, II & Final Professional examination of M.B.B.S./BDS or year-wise detailed marks certificates of Master's Degree/ Bachelor's Degree, as required course-wise.
4. The compulsory rotating internship certificate.
5. Registration Certificate from Delhi Medical Council/ State Medical Council/ Medical Council of India/Dental Council of India.
6. Schedule Caste/ Schedule Tribe/OBC certificate, if applicable.
7. Non-creamy layer certificate and OBC caste certificate as per the Central list published by the National Commission for OBC.
8. Physically Handicapped certificate, if applicable.
9. Employer's Certificate and a No Objection Certificate (NOC), if employed (as given in the application form).
10. Certificate in support of having put in five years service: only in case of candidates seeking admission to MD (Community Health Administration) course.

11. Certificate in support of experience required for candidates applying for admission to D.H.E. course.

Note: No original certificate should be attached with the application form.

- 2.8.3 The candidates who are in service should submit their application form through their employer (please see **clause 1.18**).

2.9 Procedure for Post-Graduate Medical Entrance Test (PGMET):

The Post-Graduate Medical Entrance Test (PGMET) will be conducted by the University of Delhi on 06.02.2010 (Saturday) for selecting candidates for the 50% seats in Post-Graduate (Degree/ Diploma) Courses and MDS Courses under University of Delhi. The selection will be made from the medical graduates and Dental Surgery graduates of University of Delhi.

The Entrance Test for other 50% seats will be conducted by the All India Institute of Medical Sciences directly on behalf of the Directorate General of Health Services (Ministry of Health & Family Welfare) as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India except for MD (Community Health Administration) and D.H.E. courses, which will be filled up by University of Delhi.

If any seat remains vacant under All India Quota, the same shall be transferred to Delhi University Quota.

All the candidates seeking admission to Post-Graduate (Degree/ Diploma) courses except D.H.E. course are required to appear at the PGMET.

2.10 Declaration of result of PGMET:

Result of eligible candidates shall be notified on the Notice Board of the Faculty and result of all candidates on the website i.e. www.du.ac.in tentatively third week of February, 2010.

2.11 Procedure for counselling and provisional admission to all PG Degree/Diploma Courses except the MD (CHA) and Diploma Course in Health Education (DHE).

- 2.11.1 Admission would be made strictly on the basis of merit of the eligible candidates determined by marks obtained in the PGMET.

In case, two or more candidates obtain equal marks in PGMET, the inter-se-merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as follows:

- (i) The candidate who has got more aggregate marks, in the first attempt taking into consideration marks of all the three professional examinations of M.B.B.S./ B.D.S. course together, will be given preference for admission.
- (ii) If the candidates have equal marks in M.B.B.S. / B.D.S. also, after taking into consideration marks of all the three professional examinations, then the candidate older/ oldest in age will be given preference for admission.
- 2.11.2 The candidates in order of merit will be required to appear before Post-Graduate Admission Committee constituted by the Board of Research Studies of the Faculty of Medical Sciences for counselling and admissions on the specified dates.
- 2.11.3** No communication would be sent to the individual candidates for appearing before the Post-Graduate Admission Committee. The candidates should appear before the Post-Graduate Admission Committee on the specified dates according to their merit as per schedule given at **page (i & ii)**. The admission authority would reject such a request of a candidate for attending counselling who has already been offered a seat at any Institution/College by any admission authority and not submitted/brought the surrender certificate. Candidates should report to **the Conference Center, Opposite Department of Botany, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007 on the stipulated dates at 9:00 A.M. for MD/MS/Diploma counselling. The Reporting time for MDS Counselling is 2.30 PM on the Stipulated date.**
- 2.11.4 If a candidate is absent on his/ her turn at the time of counselling and comes late on the same day before the end of the counselling, he/ she may be allowed to appear in the counselling on his/ her written request and on payment of Rs. 1000/- in cash as a penalty for late coming. Such candidate shall appear in the counselling just after the batch, for which counselling was going on, at the time when he/she submitted his/her request and deposited the penalty for late coming. He/she may opt for a course/ institution, which is available to him/her at that time only. He/she will have no claim on the seats/ institutions already allotted.
- 2.11.5 In case a candidate does not report before the end of counselling session on the specified date, he/she shall forfeit his/ her claim for admission to any course.
- 2.11.6 The candidate will be required to produce admit card, original certificates as mentioned at **clause 2.8.2** and a demand draft of Rs. 7000/- towards payment of fees as mentioned at **clause 2.11.9(ii)** for verification, failing which he/ she shall not be allowed to appear in the counselling.
- 2.11.7 The candidates would be called in for counselling in batch of 10 candidates. When a candidate appears before the aforesaid Committee he/she would be informed of the available subjects and institutions in which the courses are available. From among the subjects and the institutions available at the time of his/her counselling, he/she would be entitled to select only one subject and one institution and he/she would be allotted to the said subject and to the said Institution. Once a candidate joins the allotted subject and

Institution, he/she will not be entitled to seek any change of subject or Institution. However, a candidate, who opts for a subject and an Institution at the Counselling, if he/she gives in writing to the Faculty Office before the date stipulated for joining the course, that he/she would not be joining the said course and that his/her name may be kept in the waiting list for future counsellings, the name of the said candidate would be included in the waiting list.

If any seat falls vacant in any subject in any Institution during the course of Counselling or thereafter, the same would be filled up in the next/subsequent Counselling, if any, from the waiting list strictly in order of merit in the same manner as mentioned above.

While filling up vacant seats on account of drop out or surrender of seats or under any other circumstances, candidates who have already joined the allotted subject and Institution will not be considered and only candidates in the waiting list at that point of time will be considered.

The candidate who has been offered a seat in any counselling and has accepted the offer but has not surrendered his seat (in writing) before the stipulated date and has also not joined the said course, he/she will not be entitled to be placed on the waiting list and will also be debarred in the subsequent Entrance examinations till the duration of the course concerned is over. It is clarified that the candidates offered admission in the counselling on 30.05.2010 for waitlisted candidates have no right to surrender their seats and no extension for joining will be given beyond 31.05.2010.

A candidate who does not wish to be admitted to any of the subjects available at the time of his/her counselling may give in writing to the said effect. He/she will be placed in the waiting list and will be considered for admission to the vacant seats, if any, in the subsequent counselling in order of merit.

2.11.8 The counselling shall close as soon as all the seats of Post-Graduate (Degree/ Diploma)/M.D.S. Courses are allotted.

2.11.9 As soon as a candidate is allotted his/her selected seat, he/she will be provisionally admitted in that course and will be required to submit the following immediately:

- (i) Original certificates as specified in **clause 2.8.2**
- (ii) Fee as mentioned below:

- (iii) **Bond:** A bond worth Rs. 3.0 lacs with two sureties should be submitted by the candidates at the time of their counselling and admission. The admission will not be valid unless and until the Bond is submitted by the candidate.

The student shall have to pay the Bond money of Rs. 3.0 lacs to the Institution/ University in the following circumstances:-

- A. If the student does not join the course at the allotted institution on or before the stipulated date (except the person from the first counselling who intimates the university of not joining and applies to remain in the waiting list).
- B. If the student leaves the course before its completion.
- C. If the admission/ registration of the student is cancelled/ terminated by the University on account of unsatisfactory performance/ misconduct/ indiscipline.
- (iv) The Original Certificates of the student would be kept in the custody of the admitting Institution and would be returned only after completion of the course or on payment of Bond money, as the case may be.

2.11.10 Any candidate, who fails to fulfill the requirements as mentioned in **clause 2.11.9** will forfeit his/her claim to the allotted seat and his/her candidature shall stand cancelled.

2.11.11 A candidate who selects/allotted a seat at the time of counselling for waitlisted candidates shall have no right to surrender the seat. If he/she does so, shall be debarred from appearing in the subsequent PGMET till the duration of the course concerned is over.

2.11.12 The candidates who have been provisionally admitted in a course shall appear before a medical board on the specified dates at the assigned institutions for medical examinations.

2.11.13 Only those candidates, who have been declared medically fit by the respective medical boards, shall be allowed to join their courses. However, candidates selected in the counselling on 30.05.2010 would be allowed to join by 31.05.2010 provisionally subject to clearance by the Medical Board.

2.11.14 Any candidate, who is found medically unfit may collect the original certificates etc. from the office of Deputy Registrar (Medical) on or after 09-06-2010.

2.11.15 The fee for second and third year of the course would be required to be paid before 14th of May every year. Rs. 1,000 per week will be charged as late fee w.e.f. 15th of May thereafter.

2.12 Procedure for admission to MD (Community Health Administration) course:

2.12.1 Admission would be made strictly on the basis of merit determined by marks obtained in the PGMET. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in PGMET, the inter-se-merit of such candidates shall be determined as per the procedure mentioned in **clause 2.11.1.**

2.12.2 The selection will be made in the following manner:

- (i) For first 50% of the total number of seats, the selection will be made on the basis of the combined merit list of Medical graduates of University of Delhi and other Universities/ Institutions. Thereafter, the selection for the remaining 50% seats will be made from Medical graduate of University of Delhi.
- (ii) If any candidate who is already admitted against the 50% quota of Delhi University graduate become entitled to be offered admission against 50% All India Quota, the vacancies in the 50% Delhi University quota will be filled up from amongst the Medical graduates of Delhi University only.
- (iii) If any seat remains vacant in 50% quota for Medical graduates of Delhi University for want of Medical graduates of Delhi University, these seats would be filled up from Medical graduates of other Universities/ Institutions.

2.12.3 The candidates seeking admission to MD (Community Health Administration) course shall also appear in the counselling on specified dates according to their merit.

2.12.4 All other terms and conditions shall be the same as prescribed for other Post-Graduate (Degree/ Diploma) candidates.

2.13 Procedure for admission to Diploma in Health Education (D.H.E.) course:

2.13.1 The selection of the candidates for admission to D.H.E. course will be made on the basis of the eligible candidates and in order of preference as categorized in (a), (b), and (c) under **clause 2.7** in the manner described below:

- (i) For first 50% of the total number of seats, the selection will be made on the basis of the combined merit list of candidates from University of Delhi and other Universities/ Institutions. Thereafter, the selection for the remaining 50% seats will be made from candidates from University of Delhi.
- (ii) If any candidate who is already admitted against the 50% quota of Delhi University candidates become entitled to be offered admission against 50% All India Quota, the

vacancies in the 50% Delhi University quota will be filled up from amongst the candidates from Delhi University only.

- (iii) If any seat remains vacant in 50% quota for candidates from Delhi University for want of candidates from Delhi University, these seats would be filled up from candidates from other Universities/ Institutions.

2.13.2 The candidates seeking admission to D.H.E. course are not required to attend the counselling. The selected candidates will be informed by registered post to report to the Deputy Registrar (Medical), Faculty of Medical Sciences, 6th Floor V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi- 110007 on the stipulated date along with all the original certificates. The candidates will have to make payment of fee as mentioned in **clause 2.11.9.**

2.13.3 The candidates would be issued admission letter only after submission of original certificates, deposition of fee and execution of the prescribed bond as mentioned in **clause 2.11.9.**

Any candidate, who fails to fulfill these requirements, shall forfeit his/her claim to the offered seat.

2.13.4 The selected candidates will be required to appear before a medical board for medical examination on a stipulated date. Only the candidates found medically fit will be allowed to join the course.

2.13.5 The fee for second and third year of the course would be required to be paid in the second week of May at the beginning of academic year.

2.13.6 All other terms and conditions shall be the same as prescribed for other Post-Graduate (Degree/ Diploma) candidates.

2.14 Joining Report:

2.14.1 The candidates, who have been admitted in a course, shall be required to join the assigned institution by stipulated date. At the time of joining, the candidate would be required to submit the following in the assigned institution:

- (i) **Security Deposit:** The candidates admitted to any of the courses are required to deposit Rs. 10,000/- as Security Deposit, which will be refunded on completion/ leaving of the course.
- (ii) **Enrolment Form:** The students who are not enrolled with the University of Delhi should deposit the University Enrolment Form along with the requisite Fee to the Director, South Delhi Campus, Benito Juarez Road, Dhaula Kuan, New Delhi – 110021 through the Head of the Institution where they are enrolled.
- (iii) The in-service candidates should submit their applications through proper channel or attach a “No Objection Certificate” (NOC) from their employer to the effect that they

have no objection and the candidates will be relieved/granted study leave for pursuing the course. The last date for submission of NOC is 31st March, 2010.

- 2.14.2 The provisional admission of a candidate would not be valid, if the candidate does not complete the above mentioned requirements. After complying the above mentioned requirements of joining the course at the assigned institution, the joining report of the candidate is required to be submitted to the office of the Deputy Registrar (Medical), Faculty of Medical Sciences, through the Head of the institution concerned.

2.15 Confirmation of Admission:

The admission of the candidate shall be provisional till it is confirmed.

The Head of the Department concerned after 4 months of the commencement of the course, but not later than 6 months of the said commencement, shall submit through the Head of the Institution, a report to the Board of Research Studies for Medical Sciences regarding performance of the candidate. The report should also confirm fulfillment of the requirements stipulated under **clause 2.14.1 & 2.14.2** of the Bulletin of Information. If the performance is stated to be satisfactory, his/her provisional admission shall be confirmed. If the performance is not found satisfactory, or the requirement stipulated under **clause 2.14.1 & 2.14.2** of the Bulletin of Information are not fulfilled, the admission shall be cancelled and the candidate will be informed about this within one month of the receipt of the report of the Head of the Institution.

2.16 Post-Graduate Training and Examination:

- 2.16.1 The Post Graduate (Degree/Diploma) and MDS Courses are full-time courses. No Candidates shall be allowed to apply for/to join any other course or any post either in India or abroad, once he/she has been admitted in the course and till the course is completed.**

The candidate should complete the course as per the norms of the Delhi University within the stipulated period.

- 2.16.2 Any excess leave/ period of absence has to be compensated by extension of training period. The student has to complete satisfactory training before becoming eligible for appearing in the examination.**

- 2.16.3 The Post-Graduate Degree student has to fulfill the requirement regarding thesis before being eligible for appearing in the examination. The students are required to deposit a sum of Rs. 100/- to their respective institution as thesis protocol fee and thesis evaluation fee of Rs. 1500/- by a crossed M.I.C.R. Bank Draft/ Banker's Cheque drawn on any nationalized bank in favour of Director, South Delhi Campus, University of Delhi.

- 2.16.4 The examination will consist of theory and practical/ clinical examination. The examination of the eligible students of Post-Graduate Degree and Diploma Courses will be held in April/ May 2013 and April/ May 2012 respectively for which examination fee of Rs. 1500/- is required to be paid.

2.17 SPAN PERIOD:

- 2.17.1 Students admitted to MD/ MS / MDS courses should pass the degree examination within 5 years after registration to the course.**
- 2.17.2 Students admitted for Diploma courses shall pass the examination within 4 years from the date of registration to the course. Similar rules will apply for 2 years MD/ MS course where the student had obtained diploma at the time of registration.**
- 2.17.3 Salary in lieu of the training period will only be payable for the regular duration.**

2.18 DISCIPLINE

- 2.18.1 The student shall submit himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Vice-Chancellor and several authorities of the University who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Act, the Ordinance, and the Rules that have been framed by the University from time to time.**
- 2.18.2 The Student would undergo the course on full-time basis, no private practice, part-time job, being permissible during the duration of the course.**
- 2.18.3 University can remove the name of the student from the rolls in case his/her work or conduct is reported to be not satisfactory by the Supervisor/Head of the Department/Head of the Institution. An undertaking to this effect should be obtained from the student at the time of admission.**
- 2.18.4 The admission will be terminated if the student is not regular and absent unauthorizably/ without prior permission.**
