Applications are invited for Admission to Ayurvedacharya (BAMS) and Kamil-e-Tibb-o-Jarahat (BUMS) 5½ years Course 2016-2017 at **A&U Tibbia College, New Delhi.** The Bulletin of Information may be obtained from the office of the Joint Registrar, Faculty of Homoeopathic Medicines, 6th floor, V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi -110007.

- (i) By Hand against a crossed M.I.C.R. Demand Draft only drawn on any Nationalized Bank in favour of the 'Registrar, University of Delhi' payable at Delhi for 750/- (7 Seven Hundred & Fifty Only) for General/OBC Categories & 750/- (7 Five Hundred & Fifty Only) for SC/ST/PwD Categories between 09:30 A.M. to 03:00 P.M. from 21.10.2016 (Friday) to 07.11.2016 (Monday) on all working days (Monday to Friday).
- (ii) Application Form may also be downloaded from websites www.du.ac.in & www.du.ac.in & www.du.ac.in and submit the same, duly filled in and complete in all respects with requisite Demand Draft, to the office of the Joint Registrar, Faculty of Ayurvedic & Unani Medicine, 6th Floor, V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi- 110007 on or before 07/11/2016.
- (iii) The Application Form can also be obtained, by hand against Demand Draft from the office of the Principal, A&U Tibbia College, Karol Bagh, New Delhi.

Note:- SC/ST/PwD Candidates are requested to bring/ send a copy of the self attested Caste Certificate/ PwD Certificate for obtaining Bulletin of Information.

1. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- (A) Age: He/She must have attained or will attain the age of Seventeen (17) years as on 31st October 2016.
- (B) FOR 85% DELHI QUOTA SEATS: AYURVEDACHARYA (BAMS): The candidates seeking admission to BAMS Course must have passed Intermediate/Senior School Certificate Examination (C.B.S.E.)/Indian School Certificate Examination (12 years course) with Science (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) and English or any other equivalent qualification recognized by the University with 50% or more marks in the aggregate of three subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and has also passed English from the recognised school conducting regular classes (except Patrachar Vidhyalaya & Open School) situated within the NCT of Delhi only. While deciding the merit the marks obtained in English will not be taken into consideration.
- Note: (i) The candidates in order to become eligible for admission to BAMS course under SC/ST/OBC categories must obtain 40% marks in qualifying examination i.e. class XIIth Board examination.
 - (ii) Provided that the student has passed in all the subjects separately required for purpose of admission to BAMS Course.
 - (iii) The candidate who has passed Sanskrit as a subject at the qualifying examination will be exempted from taking Sanskrit in 1st Prof. BAMS Course.
 - (iv) For admission to the above courses he/she should has passed Hindi/Sanskrit as one of the subjects at qualifying examination or High School/ Matriculation/Secondary examination or equivalent.
 - (v) The candidates belonging to General PwD category must have secured a minimum of 45% marks, PwD-SC/PwD-ST/PwD-OBC categories must have obtained a minimum 40% marks in qualifying examination i.e. class XIIth examination.

KAMIL-E-TIBB-O-JARAHAT (BUMS): The candidates seeking admission to BUMS Course must have passed Intermediate/Senior School Certificate Examination (C.B.S.E.) (12 year course)/Indian School Certificate Examination (12 years course) or any other equivalent recognised examination thereto with 50% or more marks in the aggregate of three subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and has also passed one language except S.U.P.W. from the recognised school conducting regular classes (except Patrachar Vidhyalaya & Open School) situated within the NCT of Delhi only. While deciding the merit the marks obtained in the English or language will not be taken into consideration.

- Note: (i) The candidates in order to become eligible for admission to BUMS course under SC/ST/OBC categories must obtain 40% marks in qualifying examination i.e. class XIIth Board examination.
 - (ii) Provided that the student has passed in all the. Subjects separately required for purpose of the admission in BUMS Course.
- (iii) For admission to above course he/she must has passed Urdu as a subject either at the qualifying examination or High School/ Matriculation/Secondary Examination or equivalent.
 - Note: Urdu Diploma equivalent to 10th from the recognized Institution by State Central Govt.
- (iv) The candidates belonging to General PwD category must have secured a minimum of 45% marks, PwD-SC/PwD-ST/PwD-OBC categories must have obtained a minimum 40% marks in qualifying examination i.e. class XIIth examination.

(C) FOR 15% ALL INDIA QUATA: AYURVEDACHARYA (BAMS) & KAMIL-E-TIBB-O-JARAHAT (BUMS):

The candidates must have passed the prescribed qualifying examination from a recognised Indian University/Boards conducting regular classes from a recognised School (except Patrachar & Open School) Ref: Clause 1 (A) & (B)..
